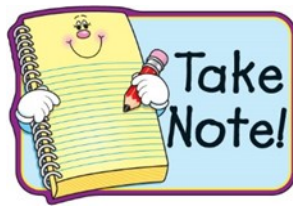
### Emergency Names & Numbers
